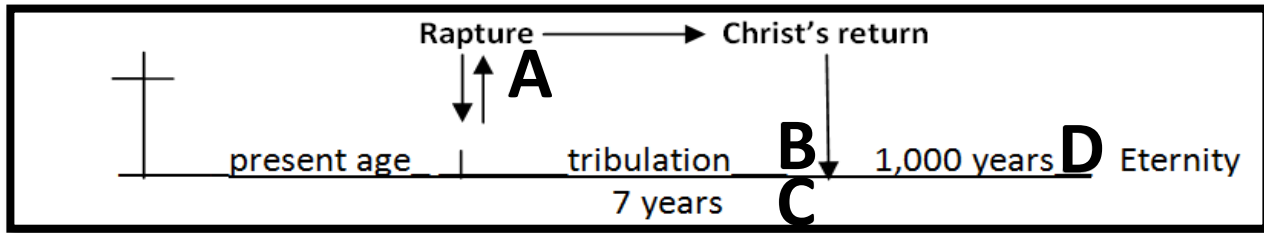


Final Judgment

Four Judgments at the Time of Christ's Two Phase Coming

A) Judgment of Rewards: Judgment of believers raptured or resurrected after the phase 1 coming of Christ

B) Judgment of the Tribulation Martyrs: Evaluation of the people who died for Jesus during the tribulation which takes place as the end of the tribulation.

C) Judgment of the Tribulation Survivors: Judgment of the living at the end of the tribulation: Wicked and Righteous

D) Great White Throne Judgment: Final judgment of the wicked at the end of the millennium
