

God in Three Persons Trinity Part 1

Definition of the Trinity: There is one God. God eternally exists and reveals Himself to us as three distinct persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Part 1: There is one true God

Isaiah 43:10-11 "You are My witnesses," declares the LORD, "And My servant who I have chosen, So that you may know and believe Me And understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God formed, And there will be none after Me. "I, even I, am the LORD, And there is no savior besides Me."

Exodus 3:15 God said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'The LORD (Yahweh, יהוה), the God of your fathers...' This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name to all generations."
